National Director's Report

There are three proposed Bylaw changes that will be presented to the Governing Board at this coming International Convention at Redmond, OR.

Proposal #1: (a) The President, Senior Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer of FMCA shall be elected annually for a one year term. (Change from two year term) These officers, together with the Area Vice Presidents, shall take office immediately following the Annual Membership Meeting.

(b) The President, Senior Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer may serve two additional one-year terms for a maximum of three years in each position during his or her lifetime.

(c) Each Area Vice President shall be elected for a maximum of four one-year terms during his or her lifetime. (Change from two 2-year terms)

Rational: There is no current Bylaw provision for removing an officer from office if, after one year, he or she is not doing a satisfactory job.

One 2-year term is not long enough for a President to complete an agenda he or she had when elected.

National Director's comment: The Constitution and Bylaws Committee and the Executive Board recommends against approval. This proposal would roll back officer election procedures to Bylaws prior to 2004. I recommend CCFMCA vote against this proposal.

Proposal #2: The fiscal year of FMCA and any subsidiary organizations thereof commences on the first day of October (was January) and ends on the last day of September (was December) of the ensuing (was same calendar) year.

Rational: This would allow budget planning six months ahead instead of nine months. More actual data would be available for setting the budget.

National Director's comment: Approval of this proposal is recommended by Constitution and Bylaws Committee, the Executive Board. CCFMCA should cast a vote in favor.

Proposal #3: After nominations are closed, and there is only one candidate for an office, the chair shall direct the Secretary to cast one vote for that candidate.

Rational: Save time, costs, postage, etc. Approval recommended by all.

National Director's comment: This is a no-brainer!


A proposed replacement for MEDEX will be offered for approval by the Governing Board. expect it to cost less and provide more.

FMCA will hold the winter International Convention at Pomona in 2012. Other sites were investigated but came up short.

Jan and I hope to see you soon on the road or at a rally. Safe and pleasant travels.

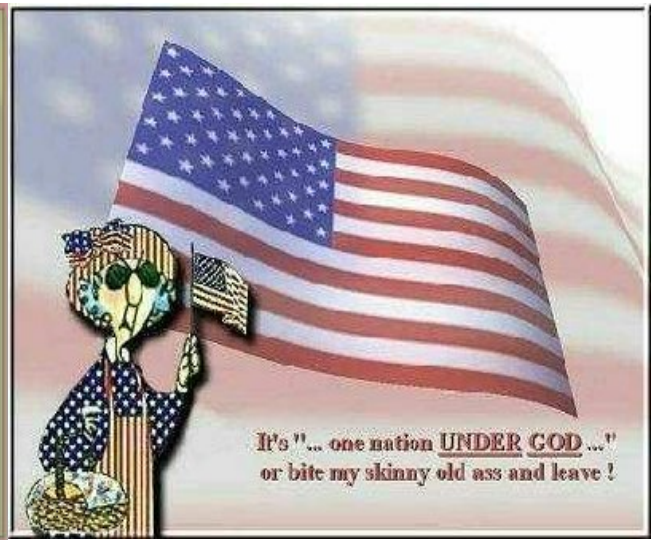
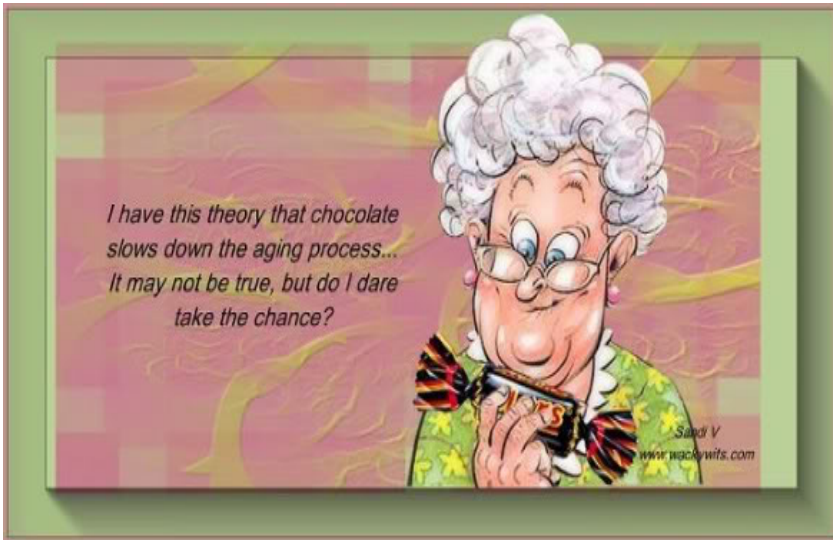

The chapter member will then turn in the postcard to his or her chapter president. When a chapter president has accumulated 12 postcards, he or she can send them in to the national office and redeem them for the Chapter Prize Package.

It's filled with gifts that can be used as giveaways at future rallies. Limit: two prize packages in 2010.

Non-chapter members can recruit, too

If you are not a chapter member and you recruit a motorhome owner into FMCA, you'll receive a \$10 recruitment coupon and a postcard, too. If you wish, you can give the postcard to someone who is a chapter member, to help his or her chapter receive a prize package.

Extra incentive: free memberships

Each chapter president has been mailed five **free FMCA membership certificates** to assist chapter members in their recruitment efforts. Chapter members can give these certificates to motorhome owners who would like to join FMCA. If redeemed, these five free memberships will count toward the 12 needed to earn a Chapter Prize Package.

So, instead of needing 12 coupons, a chapter might be able to earn a prize package by sending in seven coupons to add to the five free memberships used for recruiting.

Remember: The more members you recruit, the more benefits FMCA members can enjoy.
